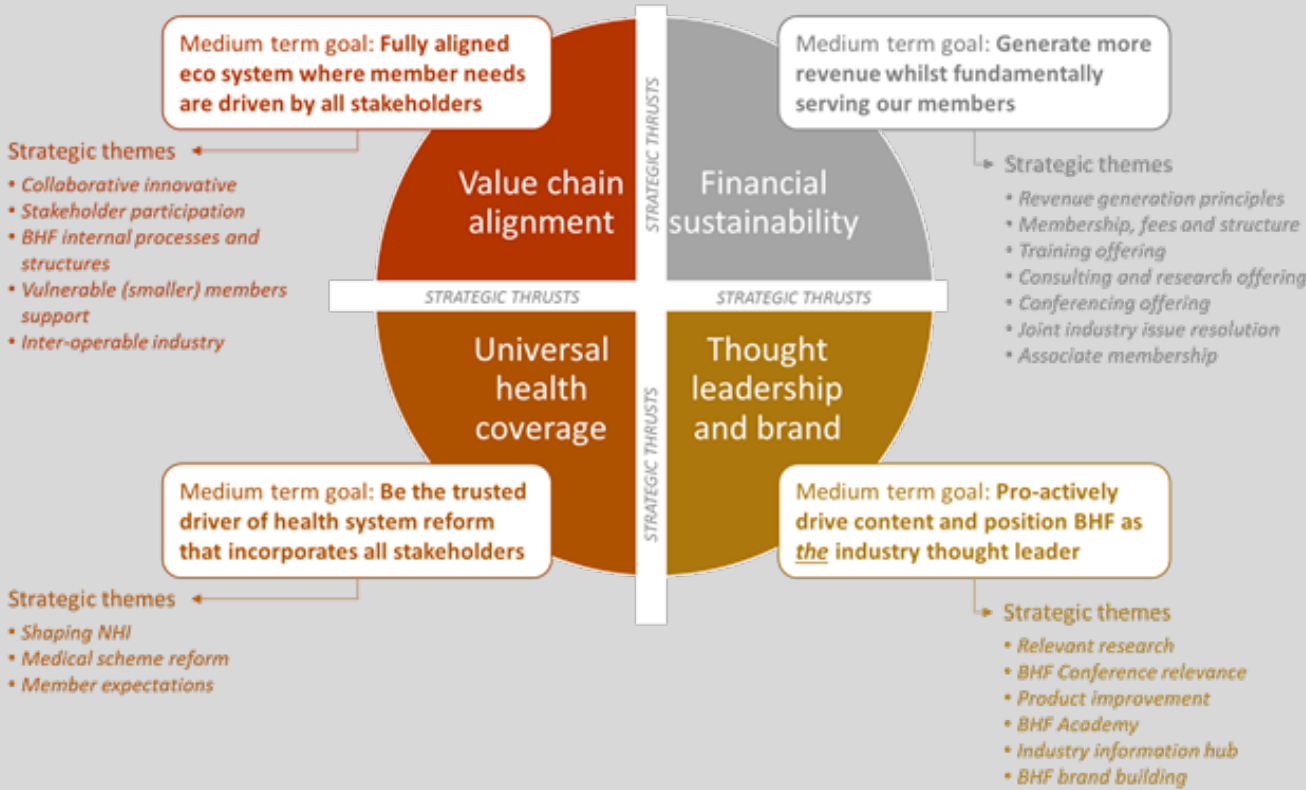

This is achieved by sharing information regarding fraud, over billing and over servicing in order to minimise fraud across the industry and to protect medical schemes from healthcare providers and medical scheme members who shift their wrongdoings from one medical scheme to another once “caught out”.

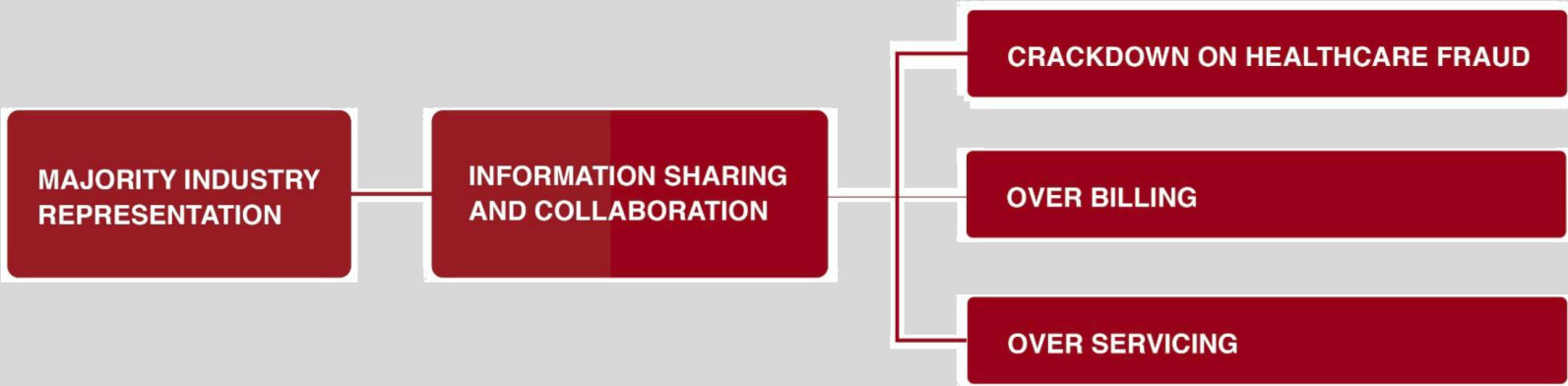
The HFMU is co-ordinated and administrated under the auspices of The Board of Healthcare Funders of Southern Africa and is unique in that it is the only initiative of its kind within the healthcare industry.

ABOUT THE AWARDS

The Titanium Awards were launched in 2014 by the Board of Healthcare Funders of southern Africa to recognise and celebrate healthcare professionals and businesses delivering superior services to their members and customers in the southern African public and private healthcare sectors.

Identifying leading healthcare performers among healthcare professionals, medical schemes, administrators, managed healthcare organisations and the industry at large, BHF seeks through the Titanium Awards to celebrate and, more importantly, to honour top performers in healthcare.

With an overall of six categories, the awards have evolved since their inception. In 2017, BHF renamed the Lifetime Achievement Award to the Humphrey Zokufa Lifetime Achievement Award in honour of its late former managing director. In the same year, the Health Journalist of the Year category was introduced to commend the works of journalists and reporters who enable access to information about the healthcare industry. This award has since been renamed the Healthcare Media Content Award and it honours the contributions made by health reporters and journalists towards raising awareness of healthcare issues across southern Africa.

This year, the BHF will cast a spotlight upon individuals and organisations in the healthcare sector who have heeded the call to provide timely access to healthcare services by introducing the Titanium Award for Excellence in creating Access to Healthcare. The award is open to all organisations and individuals in the healthcare sector, including CSI programmes, SMMEs, medical schemes, administrators, pharmaceutical professionals, managed care organisations, healthcare professional, and non-profit and government agencies dedicated to creating access to healthcare for communities.

Titanium Award for Excellence in creating Access to Healthcare

This award is open to all organisations in the healthcare sector, including; CSI programmes, SMMEs, medical schemes, administrators, pharmaceutical professionals, managed care companies, healthcare professionals, non-profit and government agencies dedicated to creating access to healthcare for communities. The award seeks to honour private and public sector, as well as non-profit or non-governmental organisations driving programmes, initiatives and campaigns that create access to healthcare for communities.

Titanium Award for Best Healthcare Media Content

This award seeks to honour health journalists/reporters for content published as well as their contributions towards raising awareness of healthcare issues across society. The category acknowledges health journalists/ reporters across any medium for significant impact to society on health issues through their reporting.

Titanium Award for Health Facilities (Hospitals, Primary care, etc.)

Private sector and public sector

This award recognises individual healthcare facilities in the public and private sectors. This award acknowledges innovations and systems efficiency in the deliver of quality healthcare.

Titanium Award for Young Achiever
